Mapping was done with the ESRI app at several locations, including Wildwood Reserve, Waverly Glen, Two Rivers State Park, and the Forbidden Trail. Maps included numerous trails accompanied by points of interest and photos. Maps were created by members of the project team as well as several others in the community to determine ease of mapping. 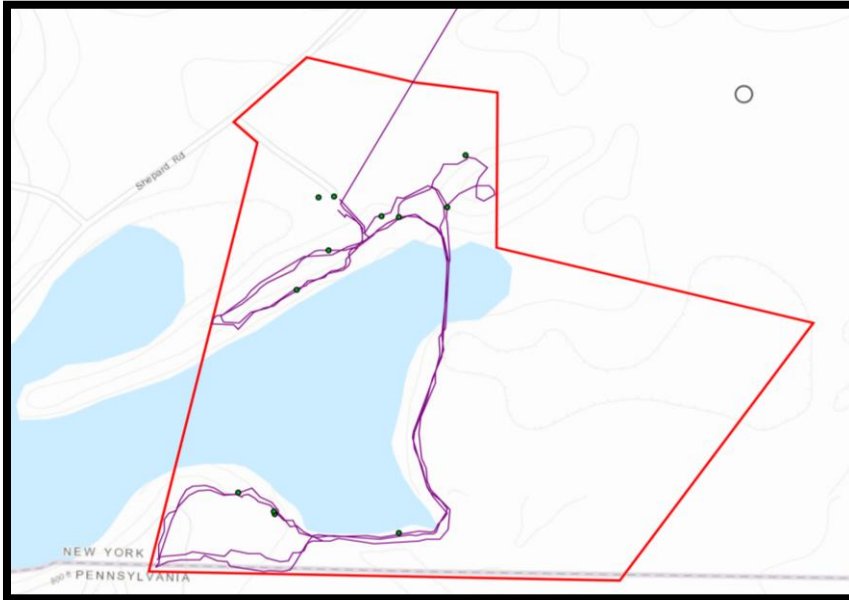

ESRI STORYBOARD

ESRI offers functionality to create Storyboards. The information included in a Storyboard gives pertinent information about the parks and organizations it is linked to. Per the Storyboard created for this project, one will discover that the Wildwood Reserve is a 50-acre nature reserve in the Town of Barton (Tioga County) owned and managed by the Carantouan Greenway, a 501 c 3 not-for-profit environmental and conservation-minded organization. It is managed by an all-volunteer board which maintains one and a half miles of mowed and cleared trails, which traverse the varied habitats of pine woods, meadow, hedgerow, pond edge and hardwoods, for public access. The Storyboards also include mapping and points of interest and attachments. Such data aids in increasing knowledge and increasing interest in our parks.
